# **CLINICS**

Lynn Semingson holds an extensive Team Penning clinic each spring. Last year's clinic focused on getting the rider and horse tuned up for the teampenning season. Lynn's feels that his clinics being held early in the spring with fresh cattle have proven to be very effective in getting the horse and rider prepared for the penning season. This year's will be held on April 4-6 and will focus on "putting a handle" on your horse and "hooking him on to that cow". With the advent of AQHA Versatility Stock Horse Competition more emphasis is put on reining and cutting. This of course helps in the penning arena as well. To create a more personal level of training Lynn only accepts around 16 riders in his clinics so sign up early as space is limited. Cost for this clinic is \$65 per day. Lynn also excepts horses and/or riders for one on one training session all year 'round.

**Brent Semingson** is continuing his John Lyon's Certified horsemanship clinics throughout the United States as well as Smoke Rise Ranch.
